Dear Governor Deal:

For over twenty years, Clayton County Schools and Clayton County government and its cities have used special purpose sales tax on jet fuel at Hartsfield-Jackson International Airport as authorized by local referendum to fund local infrastructure, and school capital projects such as Jonesboro High School. If adopted as currently written, HB 821 would eliminate millions of dollars in tax revenue that will hurt the children of Clayton County. We urge the Governor to reconsider HB 821.
